“God Has Made Us a New Creation!”

In February of 2008, I was on the phone with Bishop Moore, and she began to share with me a powerful message of encouragement from a recent conversation she had with the Lord. The following article is what I was able to capture from this glorious moment with our Leader...

“God Has Made us a New Creation”

“Just as God took the marred vessel of Jesus Christ, after He had been brutally beaten, and made Him brand new, He is doing the very same thing with us.” Notice Isaiah 52:13-14, “Behold, my servant shall deal prudently, he shall be exalted and extolled, and be very high. As many were astonished at thee; his visage was so marred more than any man, and his form more than the sons of men:” And notice Jeremiah 18:4, “And the vessel that he made of clay was marred in the hand of the potter: so he made it again another vessel, as seemed good to the potter to make it.”

“God didn’t take the old vessel of His Son and use the same old material, but He made another vessel – a new vessel – a vessel that was perfect in every way.”

“When we come to Christ, God makes us a brand new creature. The old has passed away.” Notice 2nd Corinthians 5:17, “Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.” “No one can hold us prisoners of our past, because we are a new creature! To God be the Glory!”

Notice Galatians 6:15, “For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision, but a new creature.”

God has given us a new song in our mouths. Psalms 40:3 reads, “And he hath put a new song in my mouth, even praise unto our God: many shall see it, and fear, and shall trust in the LORD.” And Psalms 98:1 reads, “O sing unto the LORD a new song; for he hath done marvellous things: his right hand, and his holy arm, hath gotten him the victory.”

God has done a new thing in us. Isaiah 43:19 reads, “Behold, I will do a new thing; now it shall spring forth; shall ye not know it? I will even make a way in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert.”

God has given us a new name. Isaiah 62:2 reads, “And the Gentiles shall see thy righteousness, and all kings thy glory: and thou shalt be called by a new name, which the mouth of the LORD shall name.”

God has made us new in righteousness and in true holiness. Ephesians 4:24 reads, “And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.”

God has made us new in knowledge. Colossians 3:10 reads, “And have put on the new man, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him:”

Through the resurrection of Jesus Christ, God has given us a new and living way. Hebrews 10:20 reads, “By a new and living way, which

he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh;”

God has given us a new spirit and heart. Ezekiel 11:19 reads, “And I will give them one heart, and I will put a new spirit within you; and I will take the stony heart out of their flesh, and will give them an heart of flesh:”

“We do not have to walk in the old sinful ways, because we are brand new.” Ezekiel 18:31 reads, “Cast away from you all your transgressions, whereby ye have transgressed; and make you a new heart and a new spirit: for why will ye die, O house of Israel?”

God has given us a new tongue. Mark 16:17 reads “And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;” We have new power over the enemy!

Finally, God has given us a new commandment. John 13:34 reads, “A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another.”

Bishop Moore says, “We are somebody! We don’t know what God has done for us! All that old stuff is gone! We’ve got a new mind! He can make things different for us! We have to love Him for what He has already done. He removed our heartaches and pain and gave us new joy. To God be the Glory!”
