The Lord put it upon the heart of Bishop Faye Moore, Senior Bishop/CO, to visit the churches in the state of Florida, at the start of the year.

Bishop Moore began her visit in St. Petersburg (1/22/06), and because she sent the Holy Ghost ahead of her, there was a mighty move of the Spirit of God. She then traveled to Fort Myers (1/24/06) to enjoy the Lord with the saints there. Her third visit was West Palm Beach (1/26/06), and the saints were so overjoyed to have the Senior Bishop in their presence, along with the visiting saints from other parts of the country. Finally, the Senior Bishop came to Deerfield Beach (1/27/06-1/29/06) to close out her southern visit.

There was rejoicing, healing, good preaching, deliverance, laughing, dancing — all to the glory and honor of God.

The Spirit of the Lord was in the atmosphere!

The men and women of God preached the gospel of Jesus Christ, with power and under the anointing.

Some of the messages given were: “The Wait is Over” - “You Got it, I Want It” - “Touch the Hem of His Garment” - “I’d Rather Be in the Spell, Than Die and Go to Hell” - “I’m a Survivor” - “Set Up for a Blessing” - “Check Your Vision” and so many more!

Bishop Moore taught fervently on the 2006 Proclamation. “Harvest Time is Now!” She read from John 4:31-38.

<sup>31</sup>*In the mean while his disciples prayed him, saying, Master, eat.* <sup>32</sup>*But he said unto them, I have meat to eat that ye know not of.* <sup>33</sup>*Therefore said the disciples one to another, Hath any man brought him ought to eat?* <sup>34</sup>*Jesus saith unto them, My meat is to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work.* <sup>35</sup>*Say not ye, There are yet four months, and then*

*cometh harvest? behold, I say unto you, Lift up your eyes, and look on the fields; for they are white already to harvest.* <sup>36</sup>*And he that reapeth receiveth wages, and gathereth fruit unto life eternal: that both he that soweth and he that reapeth may rejoice together.* <sup>37</sup>*And herein is that saying true, One soweth, and another reapeth.* <sup>38</sup>*I sent you to reap that whereon ye bestowed no labour: other men laboured, and ye are entered into their labours.*

Bishop taught...

“Now is the time for the people of God to work the fields. We sometimes want to wait until we are ready to harvest—when it’s convenient for us. But the Lord is saying the fields are already white and ready for harvest NOW! It’s time to gather the souls. We must work together to accomplish what **God wants**. We are commissioned by God to work as a powerful Team to gather the great harvest!”

“God is looking for a “**LOVE TEAM**”—a Team of people who are willing to spread the gospel of Jesus Christ with love. In love, we have to sow seeds to produce a good harvest. Some seeds may fall on good ground, and some on bad—but we must still continue to sow seeds.”

If anyone has left the Church—it is love that will bring them back. If someone was hurt in the past, we apologize and stretch out our hands in love to them. Come and let us reason together. If you are out of the Church doing nothing—come back so you can do something. There is work for you to do on the Team. We are a Team, and we will win together! Jesus is the owner of the Team, and we are the players. Jesus purchased this Team with His own blood.

Let’s work this great Harvest together with love—RIGHT NOW!”

### MORE TEACHINGS FROM OUR LEADER...

On Sunday Morning, the sun was shining brightly, and the people of God came to service in large numbers to fellowship and hear the Words of the Lord spoken through our Senior Bishop/CO.

Bishop Moore taught a powerful lesson from 1st John 4. She encouraged the people not to believe every spirit, because there are many false spirits out there. We are to believe the Spirit that speaks the truth. Jesus said (as recorded in Matthew 7:15-20) that false prophets would bring forth bad fruit. <sup>15</sup>*Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.* <sup>16</sup>*Ye shall know them by their fruits.* — Matthew 7:15-16

*"The spirit that does not confess that Jesus is come in the flesh is not of God. This spirit is the antichrist. Beware of this spirit, and know that because we belong to God, we have someone greater in us than Satan who is in the world."*

There was a time when we served the power of the world—the spirit of Satan—but now we serve the Spirit of God! (Ephesians 2:2-5). As children of God, we should know the difference between the false spirit and the Spirit of Truth. It is important to have a believing spirit. The god of this world has blinded the minds of those who don't believe. This is the spirit of unbelief. <sup>3</sup>*But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost: <sup>4</sup>In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.* — 2nd Corinthians 4:3-4

Bishop Moore continued to teach from 1st John 4, and dwelt extensively on Love — Love for God— Love for one another — Love for the unlovable. The 7th through the 10th verses of this book are quoted below...



<sup>7</sup>*Beloved, let us love one another: for love is of God; and every one that loveth is born of God, and knoweth God. <sup>8</sup>He that loveth not knoweth not God; for God is love. <sup>9</sup>In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him. <sup>10</sup>Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins.* (1st John 4:7-10)

The Spirit of God was upon Bishop Moore as she continued to teach and preach the gospel, telling of how John was out on the Island of Patmos and how God revealed some things to him to write for the people of God on additional subjects of the heart.

*"The Word instructs aged and young women on how to act."* Bishop Moore further taught extensively on how husbands and wives should treat one another.

*"We are in God and God is in us; therefore, we are to be like God while we are in this world."*

*"We are to take God's Word for what it says. When God says love the Lord with all your heart, soul, and might, and your neighbor as yourself, He means just that." <sup>4</sup>Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD: <sup>5</sup>And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.* (Deuteronomy 6:4-5) We were also instructed to read Matthew 22:37-40 as a witness passage for the scripture on love.
