Bishop Faye Moore, Senior Bishop/CO Ushers in Revival for the State of Mississippi!



The Senior Bishop/CO safely arrived in the state of Mississippi on March 20th, and on Tuesday, March 21st – she visited with the saints of **Brown Chapel, MS**, and a glorious time was had by all. Bishop Henrietta Smith, Senior Pastor, came forth to lift the offering, and God took over from there. She ended up delivering a powerful sermon on, “I Heard You Before You Called”. Following that, Bishop Moore, Senior Bishop/CO taught a dynamic lesson on, “Know Who You Are in Christ”. Bishop Moore taught the people extensively on the importance of knowing who they are in Christ, and one of the many passages she referred to was 1st Corinthians 6:1-3 “*Dare any of you, having a matter against another, go to law before the unjust, and not before the*

saints? ²Do ye not know that the saints shall judge the world? and if the world shall be judged by you, are ye unworthy to judge the smallest matters? ³Know ye not that we shall judge angels? how much more things that pertain to this life?” She went on to say that Christ’s blood cleansed us from all sin. We should be strong enough in Christ now to endure hardness – being talked about – lied on – and not running from church to church. If you know who you are in Christ, You will develop a relationship where Christ will hear you before you even ask. Just think about the Gentiles - they wanted to be saved, and God knew it, so He made a way for them to come to Him even before they asked. The service was closed in the spirit of love.

On Wednesday, March 22nd, Bishop Moore visited **Amory, MS**. Elder Renile Smith spoke, using for his subject, “I’m a Survivor”. Bishop Moore gave

comments after the message and encouraged the saints by saying, “After being a Survivor you’ve got to be an Overcomer. If you’ve ever survived a car wreck, you still would have to get out of the car to overcome your survival.” One member by the name of Rev. Donnie Babbitt was on a cane after surviving a stroke for the past four years. He survived the stroke, and now he has to overcome the results of the stroke. Bishop Moore began to pray for Rev. Babbitt, and he walked around the church and began to enjoy the Lord in the dance. What a powerful demonstration of prayer!

Thursday, March 23rd was a day of rest for the Senior Bishop.

On Friday, March 24th, the saints went out witnessing and advertising the Senior Bishop/CO’s visit.

Articles were placed in the local newspapers announcing this event.



In the afternoon, Bishop Moore hosted a wonderful luncheon for all the senior citizens who were 70 years and older. They were overwhelmed by this demonstration of love.

This began the glorious three-day weekend revival in **Tupelo, MS**.

On Friday evening, March 24th, various Ministers preached the gospel of Christ on subjects of “Repentance”; How to Have Faith in God”; Walking in the Unity of the Faith”; and “Are You Equipped for the Job”. The altar call was made by Bishop Gerald Brown and so many came forth for strength, healing and deliverance. Bishop Moore encouraged every one to hold on to their faith – don’t just come to the altar and return the same way, but walk in their deliverance.

On Saturday evening, March 25th, the Elders preached about the life of Christ, the power of God and how the Word would give us life.

Some of the topics preached were – “Don’t Touch Me if You Haven’t Pray” (2nd Kings 4:32); “It’s Time to Clean Up” (James 4:8); “Don’t Give Up” (Isaiah 41:29); “Stand” (Galatians 5:1), “My Help comes From the Lord” (Psalms 121:62), “The Sanctified and the Foolish” – with the sub-topic of “God’s Way is Tight, but Right” (talking about the foolish virgins). The altar call was effective and resulted in a former member returning home to the fold.

On Sunday morning, March 26th – Bishop Moore taught a beautiful lesson on “Love”. The lesson focused on I John 3rd chapter. Bishop Moore dwelt heavily on having a “Love Check Up”. Love is spread abroad by the Holy Ghost, which will help you forgive and forget, respect and obey. You will obey because you love God.

Bishop Moore was very thorough and effective in her teaching, and she reiterated on some of the teachings she delivered during her visit to the state of Florida.

The altar call was powerful - four souls returned to the fold – praise the Lord!

In her remarks, Bishop Moore made a passionate plea to all the young people, asking them to help her build the church back up with more members. This is the result of a vision given to her by the Lord - that it would be the young people who would help fulfill the task of building God’s house back up.

On this last day in Tupelo, MS, the Bishops brought forth the Word on the following subjects: “The Power of God” “He is Just a Prayer Away” and “You Got It, and I Want It”.

Visiting delegates for the Tupelo revival were from the Bahamas, Honduras, Mexico and there were 14 other states in the US represented.

In Tupelo, MS, the church was packed to capacity every night. It was even necessary to place chairs in the aisles and in the foyer for additional seating.

The response for this call to come by the Leader was truly overwhelming – they came from the North, South, East and West to lift up the name of Jesus in love!



SENIOR BISHOP CONTINUES TO HAVE LOVE VISITS IN MISSISSIPPI...

On Monday, March 27th Bishop Moore visited in Houston, MS, and taught on having faith. She encouraged the people to walk in faith, taught them how to pray in faith – lay hands on in faith; touching and agreeing with the spirit of God. Doing this would bring forth deliverance. Several saints came to the altar to receive prayer for strength. During this service, Bishop Moore used Rev. Babbitt (the minister who suffered a stroke years ago) to expound on the word of God. He was still walking in his miracle without using the cane. Praise God!

On Tuesday, March 28th Bishop Moore visited in Calhoun City, MS. The spirit of God came in and used Elder Emma Morrow (Senior Pastor). She spoke on the “Wonderful name of Jesus”, sharing what calling on that Name will do for you. Bishop Calvin

Wortham came forth after that with a dynamic message on the “Power of the Blood of Jesus”. On that night two visitors were there and received the Holy Ghost. Praise God!

Bishop Moore came forth in the spirit at the end of the service and spoke about the power of the blood of Jesus, as she anointed everyone with blessed oil and prayed for them in the name of Jesus.

On Wednesday, March 28th Bishop Moore visited **Tocco-pola, MS** and her message was “The Last Amen, then What?” Scriptures used were: Psalms 17:15 “As for me, I will behold thy face in righteousness: I shall be satisfied, when I awake, with thy likeness.” and 1st John 3:2 “Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet ap-

pear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.” Bishop Moore placed emphasis on how we shall see Him as He is, and how important it is to be like Him in this life.

“The only way we can be like Him in this life, is to be filled with the Holy Ghost. When we hear the last Amen, if we have lived like the Word said to live, then we shall appear like Him. If you lived a life of a hypocrite, backbiter, fornicator...according to the flesh, your last Amen will be death, hell and destruction! If you have lived like the Word say, your last Amen will be an eternal bliss of happiness and worship around the throne of God.” Bishop Moore extended the altar call and one young man came to accept salvation and receive the Holy Ghost. **(Continued...)**

MORE FROM OUR LEADER'S VISIT...

On Thursday, March 30th, the Senior Bishop/CO visited **Corinth, MS**. Her message for the evening was "How to Stay Spiritual-Minded", focusing on John 15:5. "I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing." Bishop Moore said, "You can remain spiritual-minded, but you have to stay in the Vine. In John 16:22 where Christ was about to leave his disciples, promising them that His joy would remain with them; be confident that we have the same promise. His joy will also stay with us. When we go through hard times, the joy that Christ has put in us, no man can take away. In order to stay spiritual-minded, we must remain heaven-minded, and not let negative energy get into our spirits." She went on to encourage the saints to stay around positive individuals who will speak positive things into your life. "When you have gone the last mile, and no one else is around, then you can

encourage your own self." You will be like Apostle Paul, as mentioned in 2nd Timothy 4:6-8 - ready to be offered up. Being heaven-minded is not living in the flesh but acknowledging the Christ that lives in you." She went on to read from Galatians 2:20, "I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me." She dwelled on the fruit of the Spirit from Galatians 5:22-24, and she went on to John 15:5 and 16:22 – talking about the Spirit.

The Senior Bishop/CO ended her successful visit in the state of Mississippi by praying for everyone in attendance, and then the congregation stretched forth their hands and prayed for her that she would have a safe trip home. She thanked the state of Mississippi for their kind hospitality, and began her journey home to Mt. Clemens, MI. ■
